Dear Parent or Guardian,

To provide a safe learning environment for all Park Forest Preschool students, teachers, and volunteers we ask you to review this list of questions daily before sending your child(ren)to school:

- 1. Does your child have a temperature 100.4 degrees or greater?
- 2. Does your child have a cough, sore throat or difficulty breathing? If your child has asthma, are his/her symptoms not being controlled with the use of prescribed asthma medications?
- 3. Does your child have chills or muscle aches?
- 4. Does your child have vomiting or diarrhea?
- 5. Does your child have unexplained rashes or blister-like sores on the skin?
- 6. Does your child have a sudden loss of taste or smell?
- 7. Does your child have a family member or close contact with any of the above symptoms?
- 8. Has your child been in close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID 19 or anyone who has been placed in quarantine for possible exposure to COVID 19?
- 9. Has your child or anyone in your family been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by a medical professional or a local public health official?

If you have answered "yes" to any of the above screening questions, please DO NOT send your child to school. Please contact his/her healthcare provider for further direction and guidance.

<u>Please discuss with the school director if either of the following has occurred before sending your child to school.</u>

- 10. You have had a recent visitor in your home from another area where there are increased cases/spread of COVID-19?
- 11. Your child/family recently traveled to or from an area with increased cases/spread of COVID-19?
