Dear Parent or Guardian,

To provide a safe learning environment for all Park Forest Preschool students, teachers, and volunteers we ask you to review this list of questions daily before sending your child(ren) to school:

1. Does your child have a temperature 100.4 degrees or greater?
2. Does your child have a cough, sore throat or difficulty breathing? If your child has asthma, are his/her symptoms not being controlled with the use of prescribed asthma medications?
3. Does your child have chills or muscle aches?
4. Does your child have vomiting or diarrhea?
5. Does your child have unexplained rashes or blister-like sores on the skin?
6. Does your child have a sudden loss of taste or smell?
7. Does your child have a family member or close contact with any of the above symptoms?
8. Has your child been in close contact with anyone diagnosed with COVID 19 or anyone who has been placed in quarantine for possible exposure to COVID 19?
9. Has your child or anyone in your family been asked to self-isolate or quarantine by a medical professional or a local public health official?

If you have answered “yes” to any of the above screening questions, please DO NOT send your child to school. Please contact his/her healthcare provider for further direction and guidance.

Please discuss with the school director if either of the following has occurred before sending your child to school.

10. You have had a recent visitor in your home from another area where there are increased cases/spread of COVID-19?
11. Your child/family recently traveled to or from an area with increased cases/spread of COVID-19?
